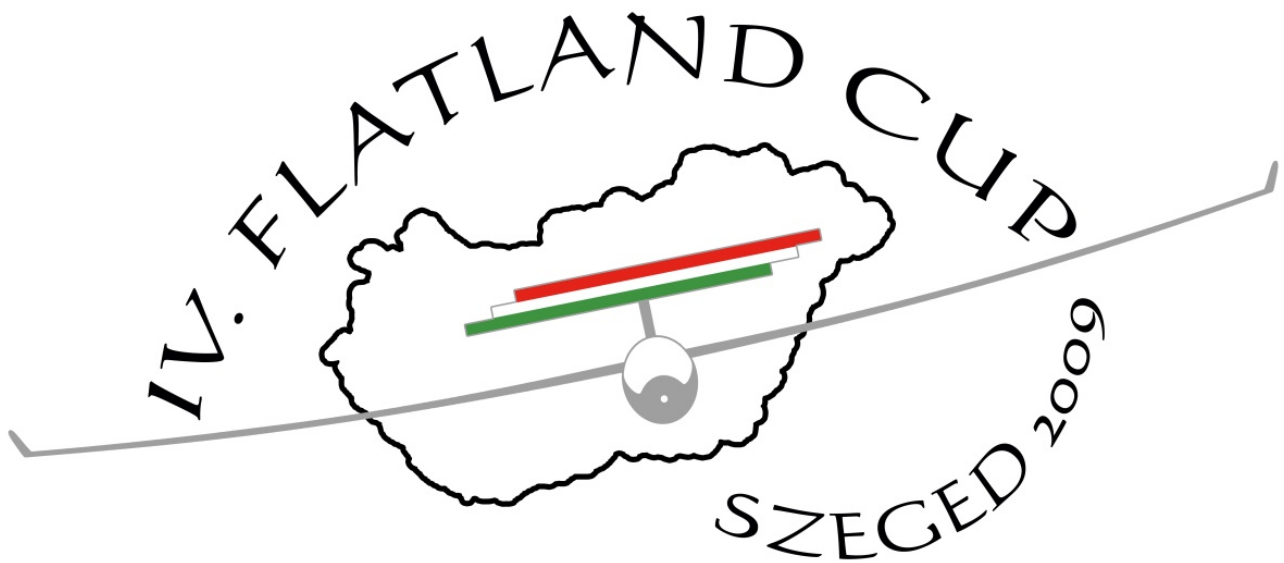

Invitation:

This is the information to all glider pilots concerning the 4th Flatland Cup, 54th Hungarian National Championship which will run in parallel. You are invited to apply online for entry to above mentioned events, which will be held at the airport in Szeged, Hungary during the beginning of August 2009.

Time schedule:

- Preliminary entries due: 01st June 2009
- Deadline for final entries: 08th August 2009 – 17:00 LT
- Training: 08th August 2009
- Registration: 08th August July 2009
- Configuration change closes: 08th August 2009 – 19:00 LT
- First official briefing 08th August 2009 – 20:00 LT
- Opening ceremony: 09th August 2009 – 10:00 LT
- Official contest: 09th to 22nd August 2008
- Farewell party 22nd August 2008 – 20:00 LT
- Prize giving: 22nd August 2008 – 21:00 LT

Competition classes:

4th Flatland Cup and Pre-world Gliding Championship will be held in following classes:

- handicapped mixed Std-15m-18m
- handicapped mixed Two-setter – Open classes (more than 18m)

Entry Fee and rentals:

- **150 € per participating glider.** You can pay it latest at the registration, when you arrive to Szeged Airfield.
- **35.000 HUF per participating glider** for members of the Hungarian Gliding Association (MVSZ). You can pay it latest at the registration, when you arrive to Szeged Airfield.
- Entry fee covers all operational costs during the contest except aero tows.
- Team container and caravans are available for rent in limited numbers. See prices and contact persons on the [website](#).
- The entry fee can be paid in full by bank transfer to (all transfer fees covered by the competitor) or **latest at the registration (until 08th August 2009 - 17:00 LT in the registration office)**.

Cost of aero tow:

- with or without water ballast: **40 € or 10500 Ft**
- 600 m AGL
- no landing fee for self-launching gliders

Accommodation:

There is a camping site at the airfield which costs **4 €/person/day**. You can rent caravans as well (see „Entry fee and rentals”) There are also many accommodation facilities in the local area (approximately about 1000 beds nearby). Further information on this can be found on the [website](#).

Catering for competitors at the airport:

There is a permanent restaurant, open all year around at the airport. A special competitors menu will be offered for lunch and dinner. Supermarkets and shops can be found in Szeged (2 km).

If needed (and paid in advance), accomodation can be reserved via [e-mail](#).

Insurance:

Third party insurance - not excluding competitions - is required for each participating sailplane. The required coverage must comply with EU Regulation 785/2004 which states the following limits:

- Certified MTOM < 500 kg Minimum Limit SDR 750 000
- Certified MTOM < 1000kg Minimum Limit SDR 1 500 000

Personal medical insurance is suggested for all team members, covering accidents and sickness, including any local hospital costs and the costs of transport back to the team member's home country.

Qualification:

A competitor must:

- have flown at least 250 hours as PIC and at least 100 hours with gliders;
- have FAI Sporting License validated for the year 2009;
- hold Glider Pilot License issued or endorsed by authorities of the country where the glider is registered;
- at least Silver badge
